We are pleased to announce the establishment of the Indonesian Chapter of the East Asia Branch of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. To celebrate its inauguration the Chapter will hold a Seminar and thereafter the third Entry Course, affording first level qualification and eligibility for membership in the Institute. This three-day course is open to everyone interested to learn about international arbitration, including students, engineers, lawyers, judges, government officials, and businesspersons.

The course will be held at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel in Jakarta from November 9 through November 11, 2006.

The course will conclude with a written examination, success in which will entitle participants to apply for Associate Member status in the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, as well as allowing the successful candidate to apply for membership of our Indonesian Chapter and the Singapore, Malaysian and Hong Kong Institutes, if desired.

The cost of the course is US \$ 500⁰⁰, and includes lunches and coffee breaks, course materials and the examination fee. A special price of US \$ 600⁰⁰ is also offered to those who wish to attend the Inaugural Conference, on 8 November as well as the course. The normal cost of the Conference alone is US \$ 250⁰⁰. The closing date for receipt of applications for the course is November 1, 2006. Course materials will be available upon registration and payment, so it is advantageous to register early to receive these in order best to prepare for the course. Registration Form attached.

A limited number of scholarships are available for this course for qualified students, judges, and personnel of the Ministry of Justice.
